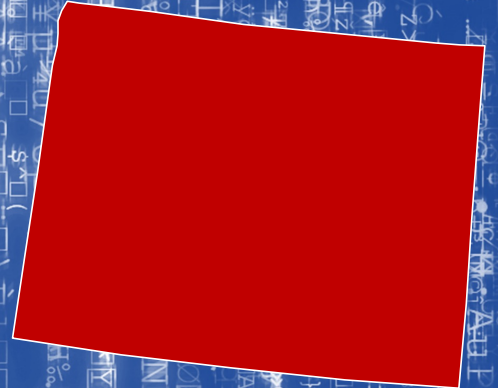

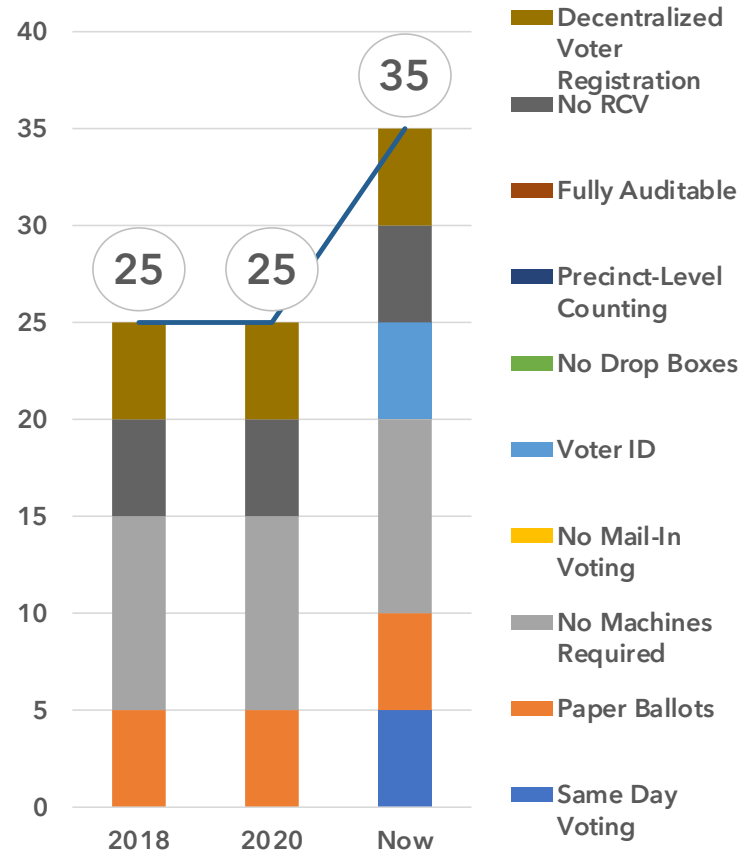

# Reason for Hope



- New Secretary of State Chuck Gray campaigned on Election Integrity and is striving to uphold his promises despite the legislature trying to take away his election authority.
- SoS Gray is working to eliminate all ballot dropboxes
- Changed crossover voting by limiting party affiliation changes to the end of the first day of the filing period beginning 2024.
- SoS Gray joined with five other Secretaries of State issuing a statement supporting an investigation into the 2020 election interference.
- Voting period reduced from 45 days to 28 days.
- Freedom Caucus (true conservatives) grew from 17 members in 2020 to 27 in 2022 with a current emphasis on growing to be more than 32 (House majority) in 2024.





## Wyoming

### Reason for Hope, cont'd



- Government-issued voter ID instituted for 2022 elections, but photo not required - pushing to add photo requirement.
- While County Clerks continually deny voter fraud, they are asking for stronger residency requirements.
- Statewide "tours" and training with Dr. Frank in 2023, working with county teams coordinated to expose past election fraud and increase voter awareness/ participation in election reforms.
