During door-to-door canvassing of the voter rolls during 2021 and 2022, there were **over 20% anomalies** found at the addresses canvassed.



In the May 2022 primary, candidate Mei Wong noticed the **election count changing on her phone at 4:30AM by thousands of votes.**



Clackamas County clerk estimates ballot count will be completed between May 28 and June 2

A printing error led thousands of voters to receive ballots with a faulty barcode, forcing county employees to duplicate them by hand.

Clackamas County 2022 primary saw thousands of **ballots being duplicated because of a printing error** which delayed counting.



Roadblocks

Current Election Law

- Statewide vote-by-mail
- Legal ballot harvesting
- No ID, residence, or proof of citizenship required.
- 16 year-olds can register to vote
- Recent legislation reverts inactive voters back to active and adds 7 days beyond election day to accept ballots.
- DMV auto registers and re-registers people.
 - If people miss their postcard or don't send it back, their party affiliation will change automatically.

Lack of Resources

- Although we are gaining momentum, our volunteers are ordinary community members trying to work with very little resources.
- In recent months, public record requests costs have increased ten fold. A 2022 directive by the Oregon Secretary of State deters citizens from getting public info. bit.ly/3dareDh

Missing Skill Sets

- Oregon needs more local volunteers who can compile canvassing data and produce reports, etc. Volunteers of all types are needed. Connect with your local county election integrity group.

Super Majority

- The Democrat party has a super majority in the state legislature. Democrats make it easy to vote and super easy to cheat.
- Oregonians will need to unite to clean up election laws in Oregon.



Victories

Public Support & Info

- **10-1 testimony against HB2681.** People of Oregon are showing great interest in election law.
- As a result of a public information request that has grown into a lawsuit against an Oregon citizen, there was a recent **admission by the state Attorney General** who admitted that the voting machines are “**vulnerable to attack through physical or wireless access.**” cleanvoterrolls.com/press-releases, bit.ly/3zKUzfj
- **Former Oregon Director of Elections exposed security and vulnerability problems** just before he was fired during the 2020 election. bit.ly/3QusyiE

Education

- **Coordination between counties and number of volunteers are growing.** Citizens are submitting records requests, showing up for election monitoring, and conducting state-wide canvassing.
