Roadblocks

Current Election Law

- Statewide vote-by-mail
- Legal ballot harvesting
- No ID, residence, or proof of citizenship required.
- 16 year-olds can register to vote
- Recent legislation reverts inactive voters back to active and adds 7 days beyond election day to accept ballots.
- DMV auto registers and reregisters people.
- If people miss their postcard or don't send it back, their party affiliation will change automatically.

Lack of Resources

- Although we are gaining momentum, our volunteers are ordinary community members trying to work with very little resources.
- In recent months, public record requests costs have increased ten fold. A 2022 directive by the Oregon Secretary of State deters citizens from getting public info. bit.ly/3dareDh

Missing Skill Sets

 Oregon needs more local volunteers who can compile canvassing data and produce reports, etc. Volunteers of all types are needed. Connect with your local county election integrity group.

Super Majority
