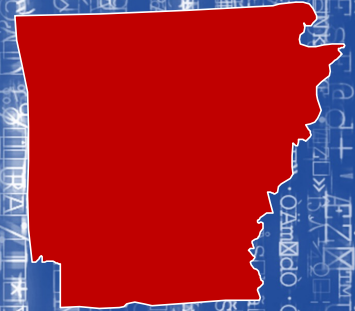

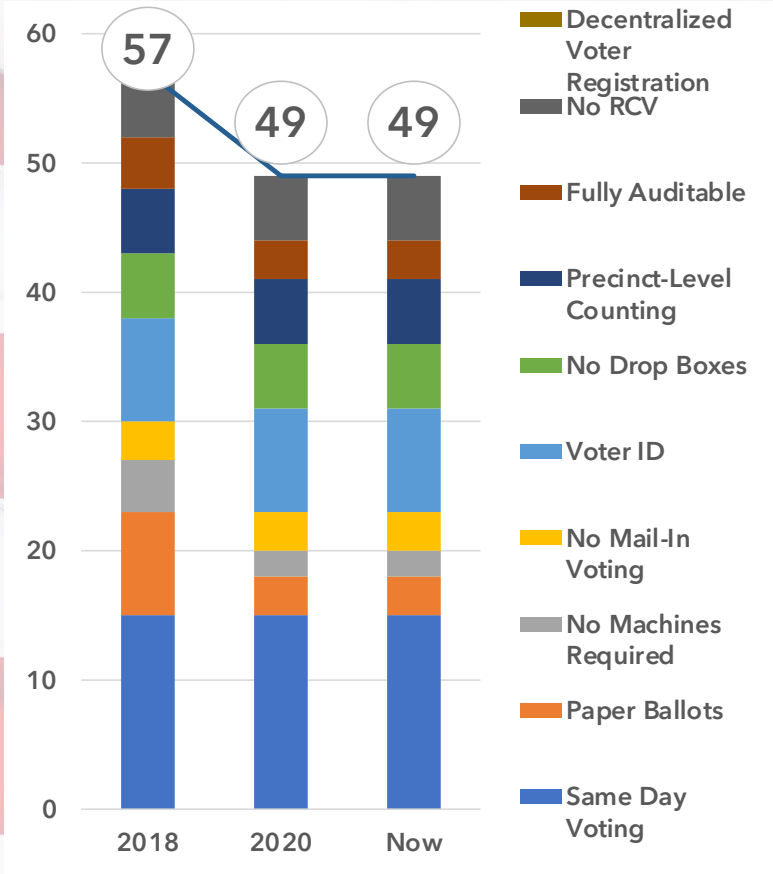

Arkansas

- Each county gets a chance to make the decision to go to paper ballots.
- The people of Arkansas are making call after call to the local officials and demanding paper ballots.
- Arkansas has no mass mail out voting.
- Arkansas has passed legislation to clean up voter rolls.
- Voters are getting involved in audits and recounts.
- Arkansas Voter Integrity Initiative has a 9/11 court date for their challenge on barcodes in voting tabulation.
- AVII has Dr. Appel from Princeton University, Dr. Stark from UC - Berkeley, and Dr. Jones from the University of Iowa coming to testify as expert witnesses.
- The voting security experts agree that voters cannot verify their choices when barcodes are what the tabulators count, not the human-readable text.
