Cranston spent the \$43,312.50 received from the CTCL grant exclusively on ensuring our Nov. 3 polling places were fully staffed well beyond BOE minimum recommendations, and paying our nine early voting poll workers to assist our office in staffing the 20-day emergency period.

So, 100% of the grant was spent on poll workers.
