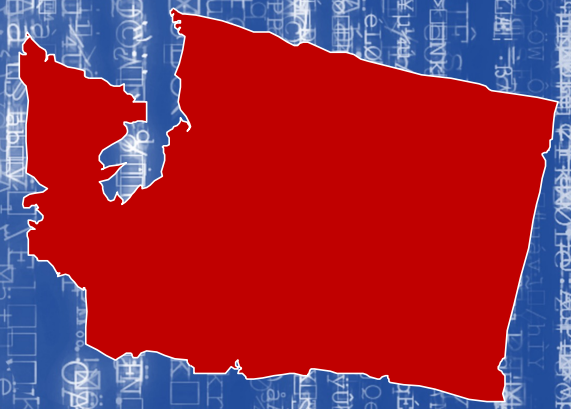

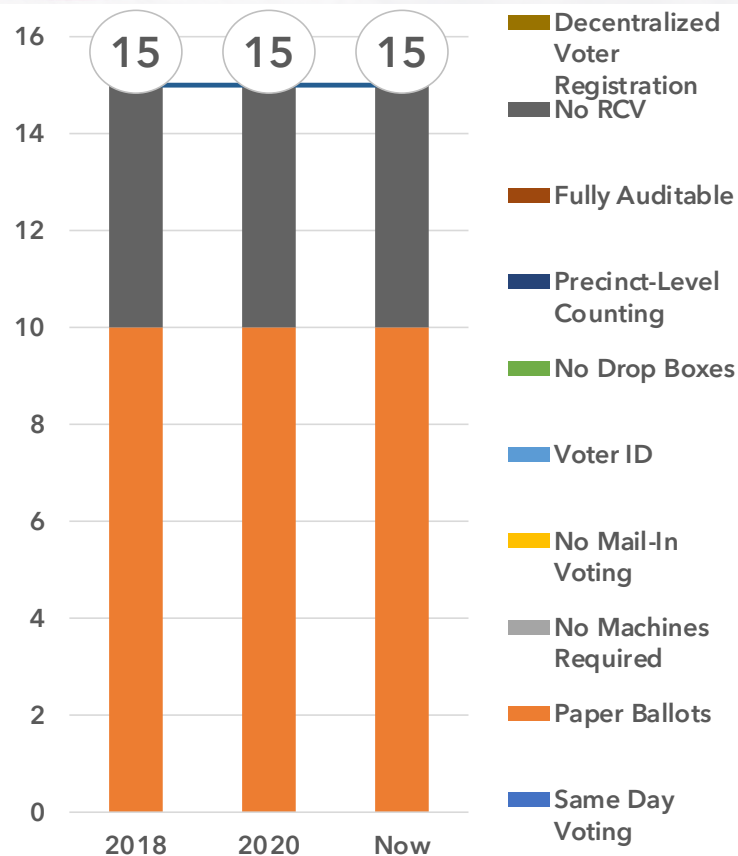

## Reason for Hope



### Washington

**BIG WINS!** In 2021-2023 hundreds of volunteers did Election Integrity doorbelling in 25 counties via the WA State Voter Research Project, to help county auditors clean the voter rolls.

- Most counties had a 40% + "anomaly" rate!
- *Anomaly: When the SoS and County voter registration database is not consistent with the voter of record registered address.*
- Skagit County: over 1,900 anomalies
- Spokane County: over 1,300 anomalies - 2.09 anomalies per address
- Dozens of multi-state voters: e.g., WA & NV
- Current registered voter in Seattle, WA and WA DC 1600 Pennsylvania Ave NW
- E.I. volunteers in several counties doing successful voter challenges.
- Hand Count options are being explored.





## Reason for Hope: Lawsuit Success



### Washington

**BIG WIN! LITIGATION NOTICES WERE SENT TO 25 WA STATE COUNTIES FOR ALLEGEDLY BREAKING STATE AND FEDERAL LAW IN THE 2020 ELECTIONS:**

- In July 2022, litigation "Hold Notices" were sent out from a team of attorneys to 25 counties in Washington State that admitted via PRR that 2020 Election Log Records were entirely deleted, not "backed up," or not provided.
- The 25 counties used Clear Ballot, Hart InterCivic and Dominion Voting Systems. The illegal deletions occurred between December 2020 and December 2021.
- This violated Federal Laws 52 USC 20701, and 42 USC 1974 which requires all election records to be kept for 22 months and violated State Laws: RCW 29A.60.110, WAC 434-262-200 and WAC 434-261-045.
- Due to threat of lawsuits, all 39 WA State Counties are currently in compliance.



## Reason for Hope: Election Success



### Washington

- **BIG WINS in 2022!**
- Conservative election integrity advocate Steve Duenkel won the Mason County Auditor race, defeating a prominent Democrat incumbent who was not in compliance with election statutes.
- Prior to election, Mason County Election Integrity Committee doorbelling yielded a 54.2% anomaly rate, confirming that the voter rolls were problematic.
- Conservative election integrity advocate Bryan Elliott won the Kittitas County Auditor race, defeating a **FOUR TERM** Democrat incumbent 54.4 % to 45.6%.
