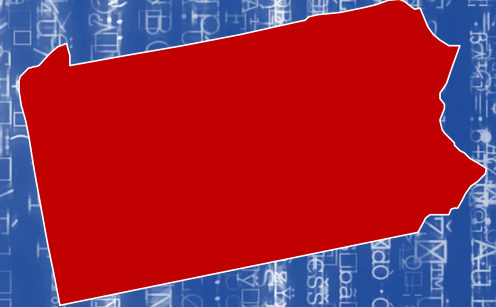

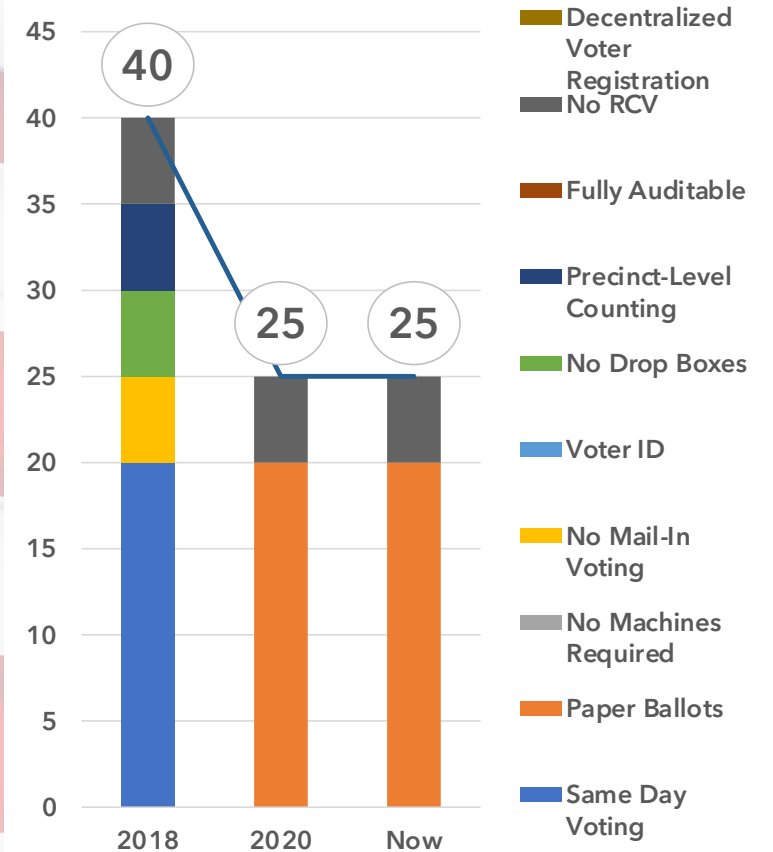

Reason for Hope



Pennsylvania

- Several GOP County Committees have been taken over by America First patriots.
- Several House Reps are hosting Constitution and Biblical Citizenship classes to educate their constituency.
- Freedom Caucus is now active in the Pennsylvania House working on legislation that follows the LIFT principles. Limited Government, Individual Liberty, Free Enterprise, and Traditional Values.
- County level election integrity task forces are underway.
- Audit The Vote PA is working on a statewide effort that will allow qualified electors (individual citizens) to clean up their local, county voter rolls.
- Grassroots are deploying the Precinct Strategy across the state to get America First patriots in local Committee positions.

Reason for Hope: Lawsuit Success



Pennsylvania

- In May of 2023, Judicial Watch settled a federal election integrity lawsuit against 5 Pennsylvania counties (Luzerne, Cumberland, Washington, Indiana, and Carbon) removing 178,254 ineligible registrations from voter rolls.
- In the settlement, Pennsylvania agreed to publish the total number of registered and eligible voters (active and inactive) in the five counties by June 30 of each year on the Department of State's website, for the next five years.
- The state also agreed to publish the total number of address confirmation notices sent to registered voters and the number returned as undeliverable or not responded to.

Reason for Hope: Hand Count Success



Pennsylvania

- York County did a hand recount of 3 random precincts from the November 2022 general election as a “double check” to increase voter confidence in the accuracy of the outcome of elections.
- Delaware County did a hand recount of 1 precinct after the November 2022 general election. There were slight discrepancies between the hand count and the machine count.
