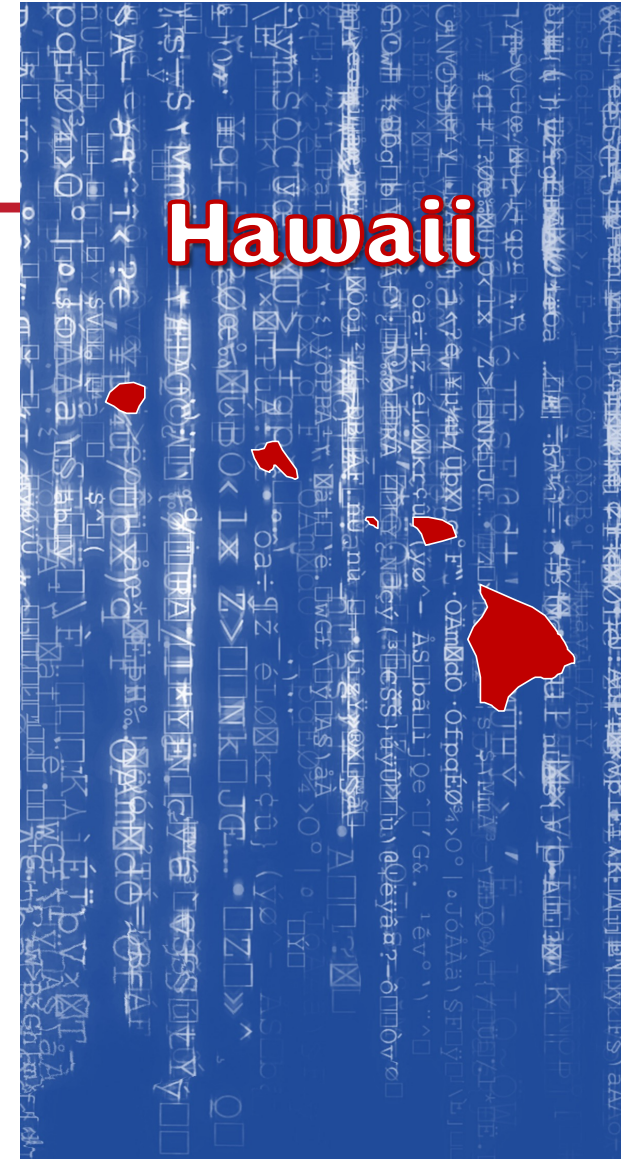

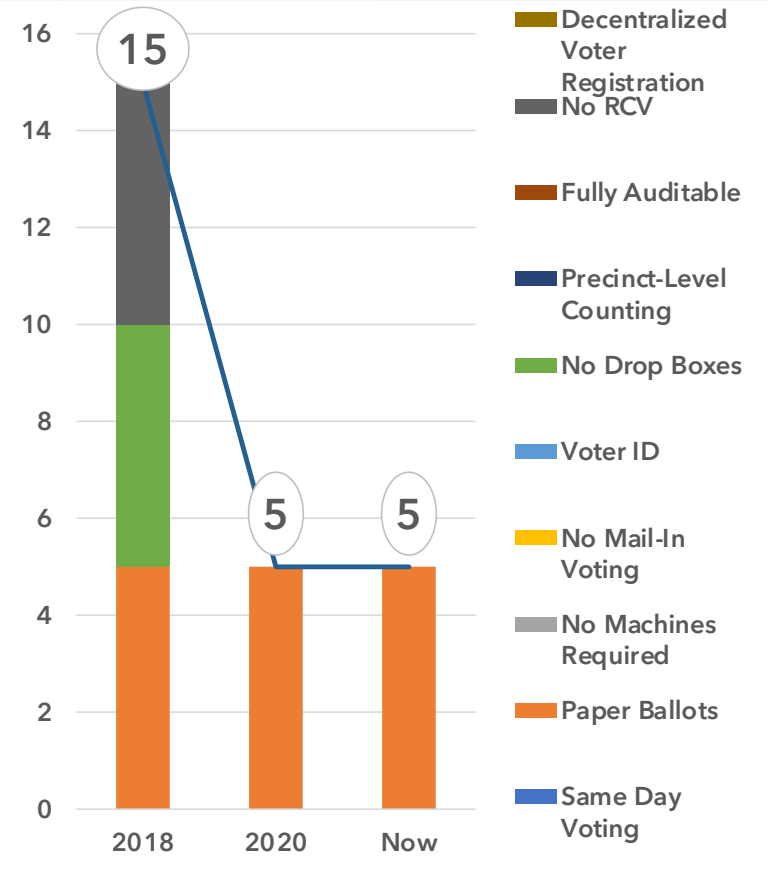

## Reason for Hope



### Hawaii

- Precinct Strategy is working to strengthen the Hawai'i Republican Party with America First members
- Honolulu County Republican Party now has an EI unit
- Strong grassroots testimony and bipartisan opposition worked to stop HB132 from passing. This bill would have allowed post-election audits to be done with images instead of paper, and removed the requirement to randomly choose precincts to be audited.
- Republican state legislators willing to consider EI bills for 2024
- Vacant Elections Commission Chair: if this position can be filled with an EI warrior, the EC can finally investigate election issues
- Neighborhood Board election results flipped after election redo, bringing light and credence to the fact that voting equipment and electronic voting cannot be trusted
- Biggest win is that we are on the side of truth, and the truth will prevail
