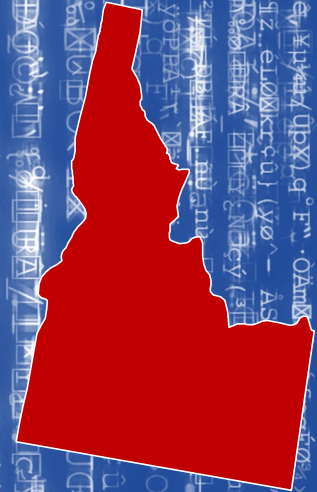

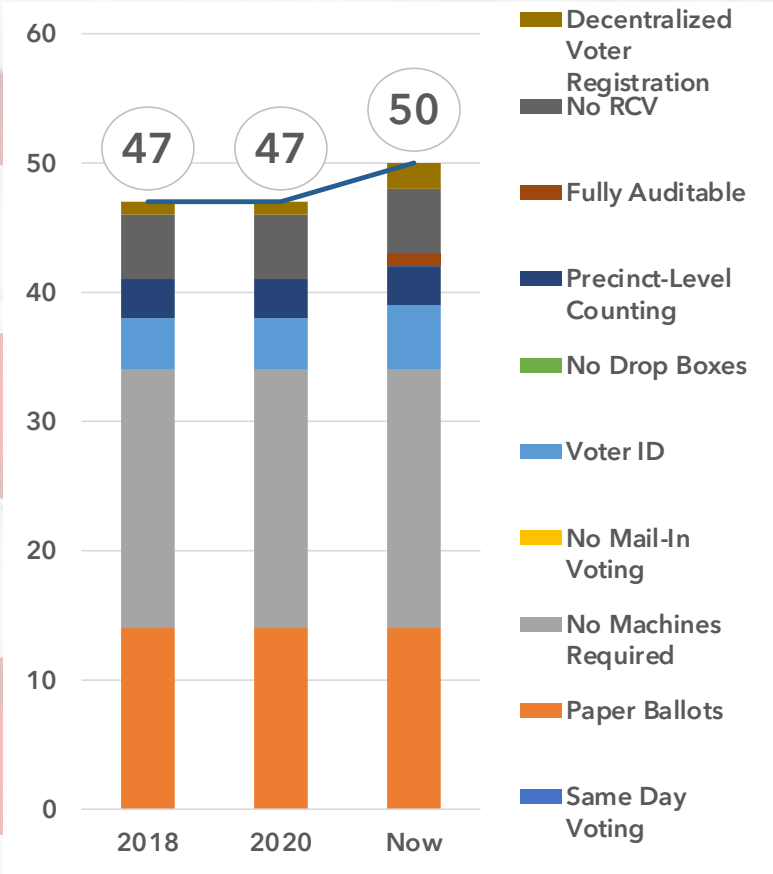
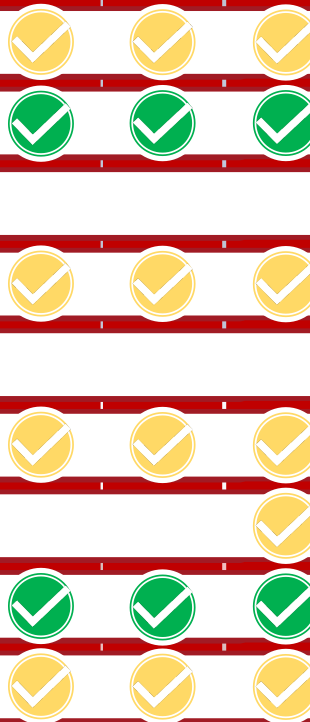

## Reason for Hope



### Idaho

- **Legislative Makeup is more conservative now than in 2020**
- **Ranked Choice Voting Ban bill passed with overwhelming support in both Houses**
- **Idaho GOP now showing strong support of Election Integrity issues**

## Reason for Hope: Legislative Success



### Idaho

- Ranked Choice Voting Banned
- From 2021, ZuckBucks Banned
- Student IDs No Longer Valid as Voting Identification
- Non-Citizens Banned from Voting



# Reason for Hope: Hand Count Success



## Idaho

- After 2022 Legislative Session, Secretary of State is now required to do random hand counts
- 7 of 44 Counties conduct full or partial Hand Counts
- Current statutes allow any candidate to call for a recount that includes Hand Counts
- Idaho's Presidential Primary Caucus in March of 2024 will be hand counted
