Reminders

- **TXT2CURE**. 8 counties will participate in the TXT2CURE platform this Election. If you would like to participate but have not yet informed me, please do so ASAP.
- CARES Act Funds for General Election. Only 10 counties have requested CARES Act funds for the General Election. <u>If you would like to receive CARES Act funds for the General Election, please fill out the attached request form and return</u> <u>it to me by the end of this week</u>. We will award the funds next Tuesday. Here are the 10 counties that have requested funds so far:
 - Beaver
 - Davis
 - Emery
 - San Juan

 - Wasatch

Upcoming Deadlines

• October 11, 2020 (recommended) - publish notice of the logic and accuracy test in a newspaper of general circulation. The test must occur anytime before ballots are counted, so this deadline may vary. Refer to 20A-4-104(1)(b)(i).

State of Utah Mail - CARES Act Funding Request

- October 13, 2020 if there is a bond on the general election ballot, this is the last day that the issuing authority can begin printing its notice of election in newspapers, posting on the Utah Public Notice website, posting on the authority's website, and positing in accordance with 45-1-101. Refer to 11-14-202(1)(a)(i).
- October 13, 2020 first day that the county can send mail ballots to active registered voters. Refer to 20A-3a-202(2)(a).
- October 13, 2020 (recommended) conduct logic and accuracy tests on voting and tabulation equipment. The test must occur before ballots are counted, so this deadline may vary. Refer to 20A-4-104(1).
- October 14, 2020 last day that a local district can cancel its election. Refer to 20A-1-206(3)(c).
- October 15, 2020 last day to publish a notice of times, dates, and locations of early voting locations and drop boxes in a newspaper and on various websites. Refer to 20A-3a-604(1)(e) and 20A-5-403.5 for more information.
- October 19, 2020 if a local district cancels its election, it must publish a notice on its website and on vote.utah.gov. Refer to 20A-1-206(4).
- October 19, 2020 (recommended) the county clerk must physically inspect polling places to ensure access by a person with a disability. This must be done before the polling location is used, so it may vary by county. Refer to 20A-5-403(3).
- October 20, 2020 last day that a county can mail its first mailing of ballots to active registered voters. Ballots can continue to be mailed to voters upon registration until October 27th. Refer to 20A-3a-202(2)(a).
- October 20, 2020 in-person early voting period begins. Refer to 20A-3a-601(2)(a).

Thanks for allowing us to clarify!

Because of COVID-19, we are doing everything in our power to encourage only the people who need to use in-person voting to go to an early or election day vote center. In an effort to encourage people to vote their by-mail ballots, we have put a sticker in the instructions to dissuade people from going to in-person voting (for those who show up just to get a sticker.) This protects the other voters and poll workers from unnecessary additional traffic at the vote enters.
