

Reason for Hope



Nevada

- Most counties allow paper ballots at the polls, NOT Washoe County and Clark County
- Public sentiment is for paper-only
- Nevada law requires counties to report a Cast Vote Record, which is best generated by a machine
- Nye County performed a hand count as a comparison to machine count and proved hand counting still works well
- New laws restrict drop boxes to polling locations and they must be monitored



Reason for Hope: Lawsuit Success



Nevada

- Filed 2 class action lawsuits in 2 largest counties
- Secured court orders for total observation process for Nevada
- Set up county's largest sting operation and when county and SoS didn't take action on what we discovered, we filed more lawsuits
- Currently we have a lawsuit against Governor and Secretary of State to strike down Senate Bill 206 which made it a class E felony and 4 years in jail to annoy an election worker
- Recent lawsuit against the County, County Manager, County ROV, and County Commission Chair filed on 7/25/23
- If this lawsuit is successful, we will fire 3 public self-servants, expose the election issues, then remedy the election issues.
