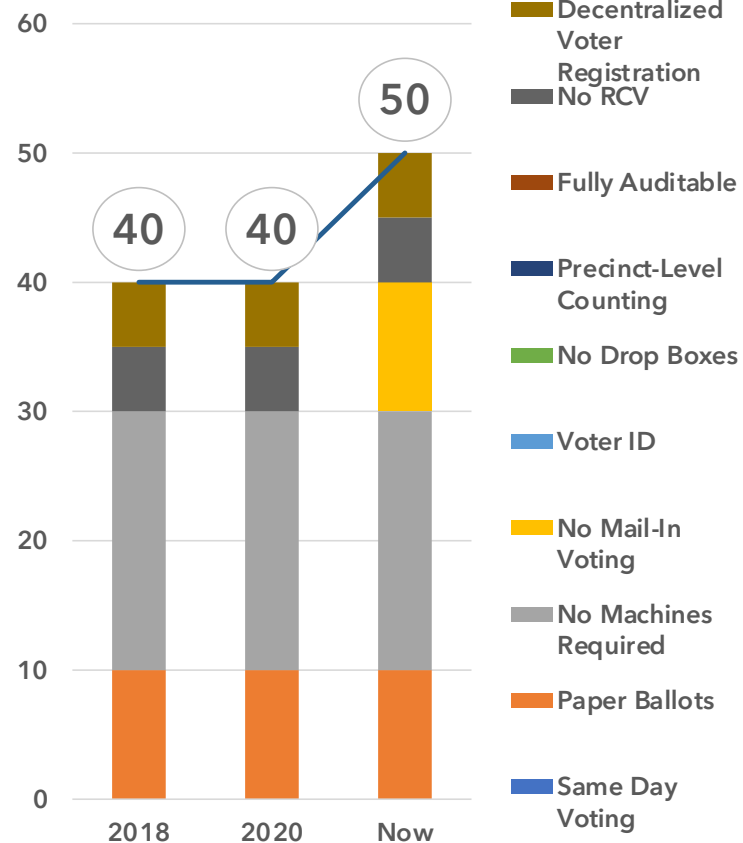

New Voter ID Law:

- On January 6, 2023, Governor Mike DeWine signed House Bill 458 into law, making several changes to Ohio's election laws, including the addition of a photo identification requirement. Previously, Ohio voters were able to present non-photo identification such as utility bills or bank statements when voting.
