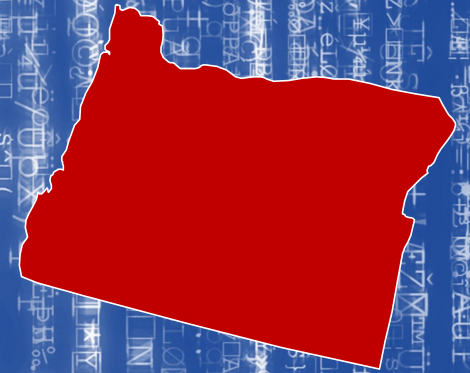

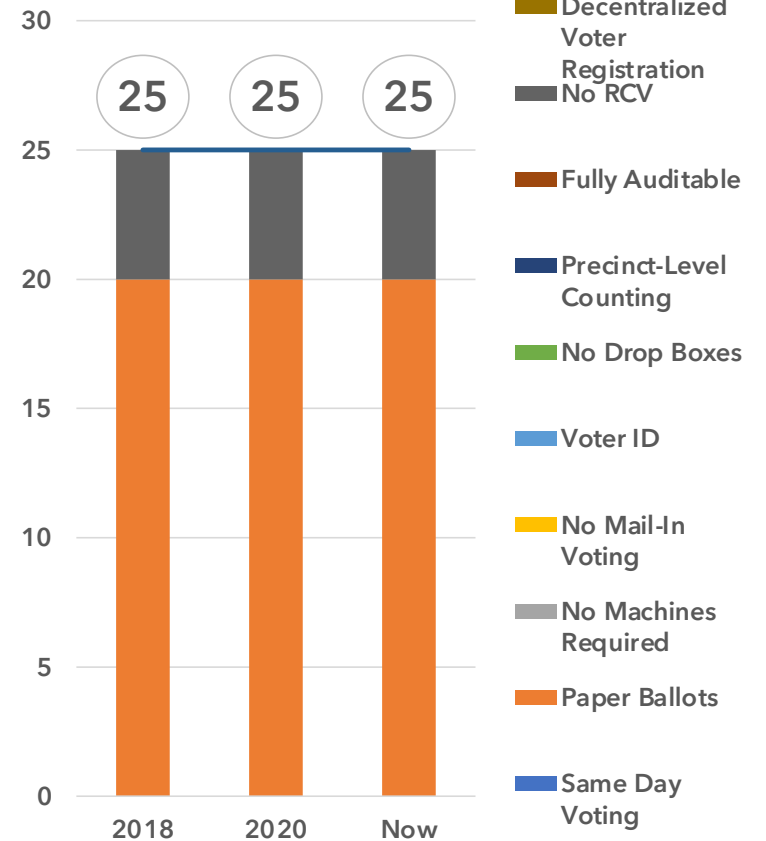

Reason for Hope



- Local clerks now rising up to express concern with recently passed HB2004A to refer Rank Choice Voting to the voters because it would take the county role of ballot counting and give it to the SoS, against Oregon law.
- Republican Senate walked out of 2023 Legislative session to protest controversial bills. This stopped SB579 that would allow felons to register and vote from prison.
- Newspaper Willamette Week disclosed OR SoS connected to being paid by Oregon largest Pot Retailer, La Mota. SoS Fagan was a consultant for La Mota while SoS office audited the Pot business. SoS resigned and is under investigation.
- The other Oregon Democratic Leaders were exposed by Willamette Week as having also taken money from La Mota. Collectively they took over \$200K in donations while La Mota did not pay their taxes. Democrats said they have now donated these funds to non-profits.
- Oregon has 4 lawsuits on Elections.
