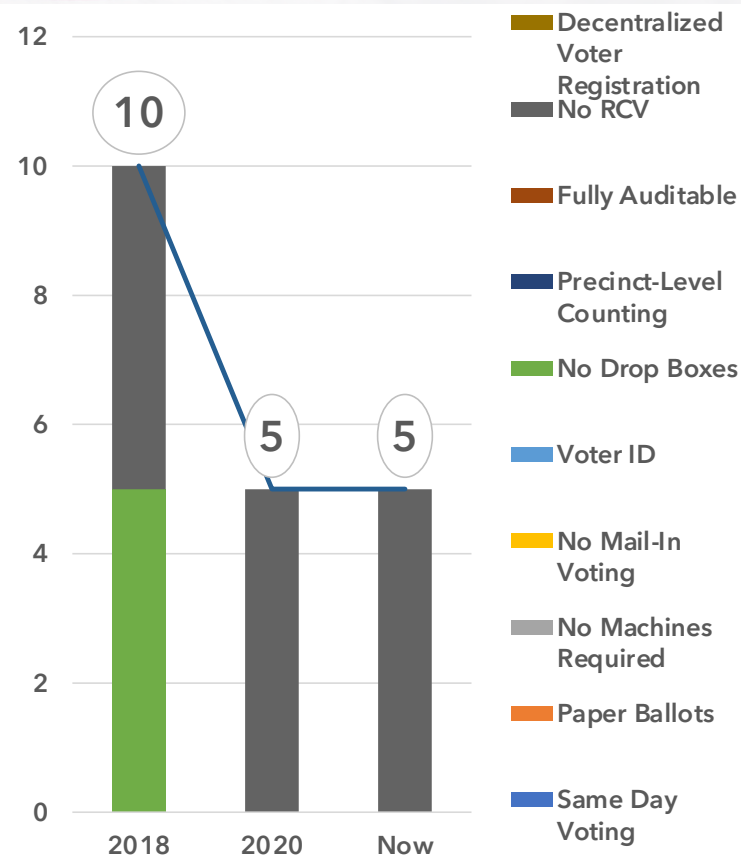

### Connecticut

- Citizens collected comprehensive election records from all 169 towns
- State data is available for investigation
- Small group of analysts leading the charge & covering the costs
- National partners increasing
- Social media presence increasing
- Citizen awareness increasing
- Citizen volunteers increasing
- Citizens are organizing
- Citizens are speaking up & testifying
- Citizens are deserting democrat party affiliation
- Lawsuits filed by citizens
- SEEC (State Elections Enforcement Commission) complaints filed



## Reason for Hope: Lawsuit Success



### Connecticut

- **Fay v. Merrill (338 Conn.1(2021))**
  - Challenged "sickness" as a broad term encompassing pandemic, despite history
  - Citing lack of "approved vaccine" while ignoring valid treatments
  - The lawsuit exposed the collusion between the legal system, presiding Governor's office & the Legislature to sidestep Due Process to amend CT's Constitution.
  - Simply put, they redefined a word, then amended our State Constitution without Due Process.
