- Purchase of additional handicap accessible voting booths
- Radio ads
- Video describing voting process with COVID precautions
- BOD laptops, cases, printer & installation
- Wipes and sanitizer

2. What were some challenges and major issues the county faced in responding to the pandemic?

- Additional employees, training
- Additional equipment/supplies
- Cleaning & sanitizing requirements
- Individual voter circumstances, i.e., quarantined, ballot not received - curbside assistance
- Responding to voter questions/concerns
- Same-day registration - overload - 4,750 Provisional ballots
