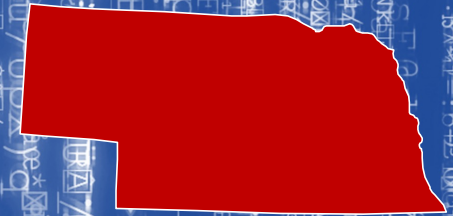

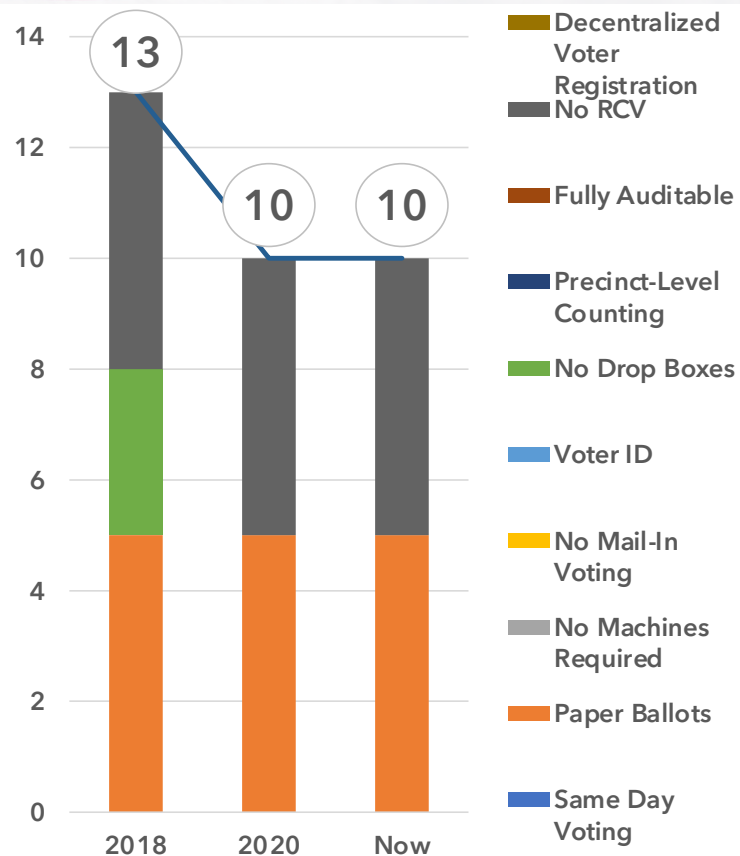

Reason for Hope



Nebraska

- Citizens are working hard to educate citizens and county commissioners on the issues with our election systems
- Several counties have residents working towards hand-counting ballots
- Joining ERIC is not going to happen due to the success in other states exposing and leaving
- Precinct Strategy takeover of the state GOP party, giving power back to the people to put forward election integrity legislation
- Massive citizen turnout in legislative hearings supporting legitimate EI changes
- Citizens overwhelmingly passed Photo Voter ID constitutional amendment

Reason for Hope: Legislative Success



Nebraska

- 6 election integrity bills were sponsored last session by senators
- Bills remain in committee, we have commitments from the committee chair to put forward a consolidated bill in 2024 to address issues
- Some bills include:
 - Requiring equipment to be "Made in the USA"
 - Securing county authority to hand count ballots
 - Voter ID that reduces absentee voting and identifies legal voters
 - Requiring serialized, currency-grade paper ballots

Reason for Hope: Hand Count Success



Nebraska

- The People are working to demand hand counts
- Several counties trying to get this accomplished via County Commissioners
- County officials are threatened by SoS office if they try to exercise autonomy in their elections
