1.0 Introduction to OCVR Reports

This guide provides a detailed description of the Reports modules that are part of the Oregon Centralized Voter Registration system (OCVR).

Accessing the Reports Modules

The OCVR application's main menu and starting point is accessed over the Internet using your Web browser. After logging in to the OCVR system, the main menu displays.



All OCVR modules are accessed from this menu. They are grouped in five sections: Voters, Elections, Petitions, Administration, and Reports. This guide describes the modules in the Reports section, which are used to print a variety of reports, search DMV records, schedule large processing jobs, or print and/or export batches of voter correspondence.

User Access Levels

Depending on your user access level, you may not see all of the modules on your display that are shown above. In fact, if your role is limited to only one module, you may not see the OCVR main menu at all. Instead, you will see the main screen of the module you are authorized to use.

IMPORTANT SERVER REPLICATION NOTE:

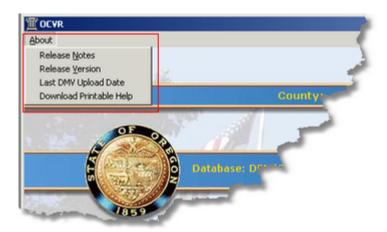
To ensure the availability of your OCVR application, it runs on more than one server at the same time. When you make changes to your data on one server, it is automatically replicated to the other server(s). While this replication occurs every few minutes, it could be interrupted temporarily if one server suddenly becomes unavailable. In such cases, you are disconnected from the unavailable server and immediately reconnected to a different server. However, if replication has not happened yet, the data you just entered may appear to be missing.

IF YOU EXPERIENCE THIS, DO NOT RE-ENTER THE DATA. Doing so could cause a conflict during the next replication attempt, resulting in the loss of the data. Instead, log out, then log back in again. If the data is still missing, please contact the Help Desk.

1.1 Menu Options

The "About" item on the menu bar on the main OCVR screen has four options, shown below.



These options are described below.

Release Notes

You can view the Release Notes by clicking **About** on the menu bar, then selecting **Release Notes** on the drop-down list. The Release Notes are descriptions of the changes and bug fixes that have been implemented in each application release. They are organized first by Release Version, then by module.

You can print all of the Release Notes by clicking **Print** at the bottom of the screen, or you can print just the current screen by clicking **Print Screen** on the upper right side of the screen.

Release Version

You can view the current version information for the OCVR application by clicking **About** on the menu bar, then selecting **Release Version** on the drop-down list.

The version information displays in a small prompt as follows:



Last DMV Upload Date

You can view the date of the last upload of DMV records to the system by clicking **About** on the menu bar, then selecting **Last DMV Upload Date** on the drop-down list.

The information displays in a small prompt as follows:



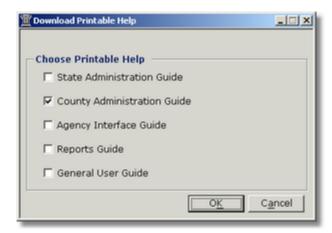
Download Printable Help

You can download the most current PDP versions of the OCVR user guides by following the procedure below.

1. Select **Download Printable Help** from the About menu on the main OCVR screen to display the Download Printable Help screen.



2. Choose one or more user guides to download by selecting from the list in the Choose Printable Help area.



Following are descriptions of the user guides:

Note: All of the user guides include an introduction to that specific guide, an overview of the main menu, and a "Glossary of OCVR Terms."

State Administration Guide: Developed mainly for state-level users, this guide contains information on the following modules: System Configuration, User Administration, Alerts, Document Templates, Load External Data, and Troubleshooting. It contains procedures for OCVR features that are accessible to both SOS and county users and those features that are accessible to only SOS users.

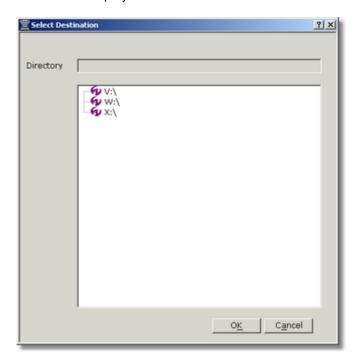
County Administration Guide: Developed mainly for county-level users, this guide contains information on the following modules: System Configuration, User Administration, Alerts, Document Templates, Load External Data, and Troubleshooting. It contains procedures for OCVR features that are accessible to both county and SOS users and those features that are accessible to only county users.

Agency Interface Guide: This guide contains information on and procedures for the DMV Search module.

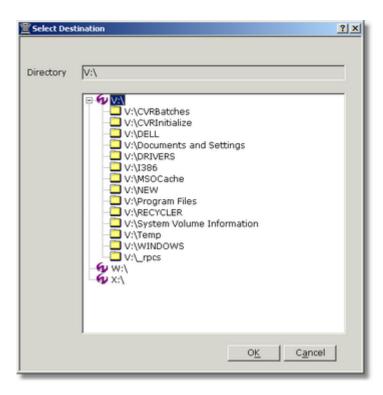
Reports Guide: This guide contains information on and procedures for the following modules: Reports & Labels, Schedule Jobs, and Batch Management.

General User Guide: This guide contains information on and procedures for the core modules of the OCVR system, which are the following: Voter Registration, Voter Search, Voter Merge, Batch Scan, Election Management, Ballot Processing, Districts & Precincts, Election Workers, Petitions, and Troubleshooting.

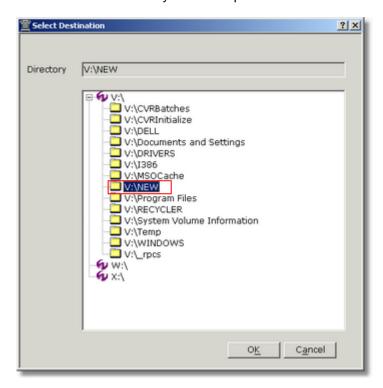
3. Click **OK** to display the Select Destination screen.



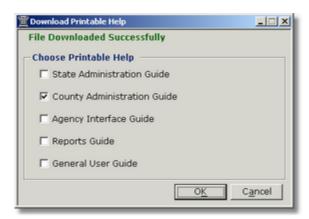
4. Select any of the listed drives, and then click the plus sign (+) to the left of the drive letter to display your Local Disk (C:) drive.



5. Select the drive in which you want to place the PDF file.

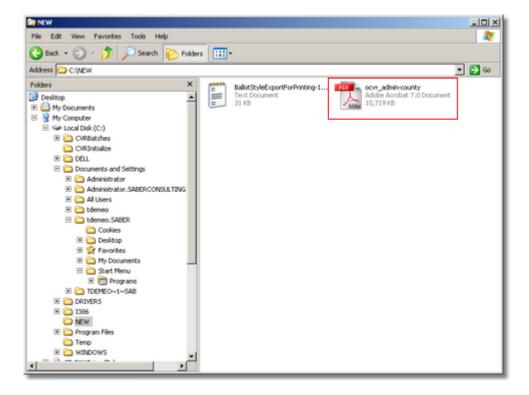


6. Click **OK**. The "File Downloaded Successfully" message appears at the upper left of the Download Printable Help screen.



7. Click Cancel to close the Download Printable Help screen.

You can now view or print the selected user guide that you have downloaded into a folder on your C: drive.



1.2 Secondary Menu Bar

There is a second menu bar on the OCVR main screen as shown below.



Some of the items on this secondary menu bar are for information only, while other options are used for application functions. The items on this menu bar are described below.

User:

This item displays the name of the currently signed-on user of the OCVR application.

County:

This item displays the name of the county where the current user is signed on.

Date:

This item displays the current date.

Password

Use this option to set, reset, or update your password for the OCVR application. Remember that in most cases you must change your password every 90 days or so.

Click Password to display the Password screen shown below.



Note: The User Name field contains the name of the currently signed-on user.

To change your password, be sure that your user name is in the User Name field, then enter your current password and your new password in the applicable fields.



You must enter the new password twice--once to set it and then again to confirm it--and these entries in the New Password and the Confirm Password fields must be the same or the system does not accept the change.

The requirements for the new password are as follows:

- The password must begin with a lower case letter.
- The password must contain at least seven (7) characters.
- The password must contain at least one number and one special character (! @ # \$ % ^ & * _ -).
- The password cannot contain any part of your name.

Note: System Administrators can also change their own password and other user passwords in the User Administration module.

When you are finished, click Save.

Feedback

Use this option to send feedback to Saber Consulting regarding the OCVR application.

Click **Feedback** to open the prompt shown below, which provides the URL for SPIRIT--the issue-tracking software for the OCVR application.



Help

Click this option to open the Help system.

Exit

Click this option to exit the OCVR application, logging off the current user and logging out of the application.

1.3 Refresh Link

Alerts appear in a list view on the main screen. To view alerts, click the **refresh alerts** link at the lower right of the main OCVR screen.



2.0 Reports and Labels

You can use the Reports & Labels module to create many kinds of reports and labels relating to the entire election process. These reports can easily be customized to contain any set of data required.

Both state and county elections officials have access to the Reports and Label module. Users at both levels can create, view, and print reports and labels, though the reports available vary from user to user, depending on their level of access.

OCVR tracks each time a report is run and notes what county ran it. This information is stored in the database and accessed by administrators through SQL Developer.

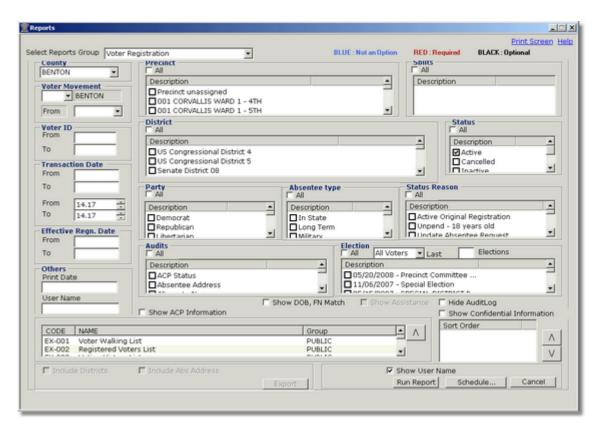
Main Features

Reports and labels of many kinds can be generated and printed using the existing report formats. The reports are grouped into the following categories:

- Voter Registration
- Election Management
- Districts & Precincts
- Petitions
- Election Workers
- Address Library
- Ballot Processing
- Master Look up

Access the Reports & Labels Module

To access the Reports & Labels module, select **Reports & Labels** under the **Reports** section heading on the OCVR main menu.



The Reports screen opens. By default, it opens to the fields for Voter Registration.

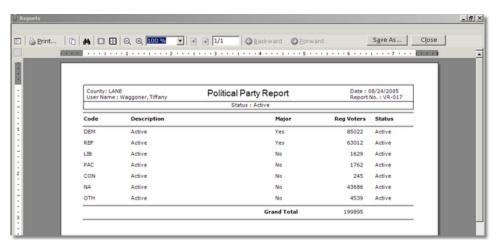
All of the available reports and labels are created through choices you make on this screen. Also, a description of the export or report you have selected displays in blue text at the lower left corner of the screen.

Note: There are very specific rules which govern when the phone numbers of ACP and Confidential voters are shown in reports. These pertain mainly to the Registered Voters Report (VR-011) and Registered Voters List Export (EX-002). For a detailed listing of these rules, see the <u>Confidential Phone Numbers in Reports</u> topic.

2.1 Creating Reports

To create a custom report in OCVR, follow these steps:

- Select the report category you want from the drop-down list in the field labeled Select Reports Group.
- 2. Select one of the report formats from the list at the bottom of the screen.
- 3. Make the appropriate data entries and selections to format the report you want.
- 4. Click Run Report.
 - a. If you left out data that is required, this symbol flashes next to the problem field. Move the mouse cursor over the symbol for a tip about the nature of the problem.
 - b. If all of the required data is selected, the print preview screen displays a preview of the printed report.
 - c. While the preview is displayed, the tools at the top of the report screen let you do a number of tasks (for example, you can see a table of contents, print, copy, search for a word, view multiple pages, zoom in and out, scroll through the pages, save, and close).



- 5. To print the report, click **Print**.
- To schedule the printing for a later time, close the print preview screen and click **Schedule**at the bottom of the Reports screen.

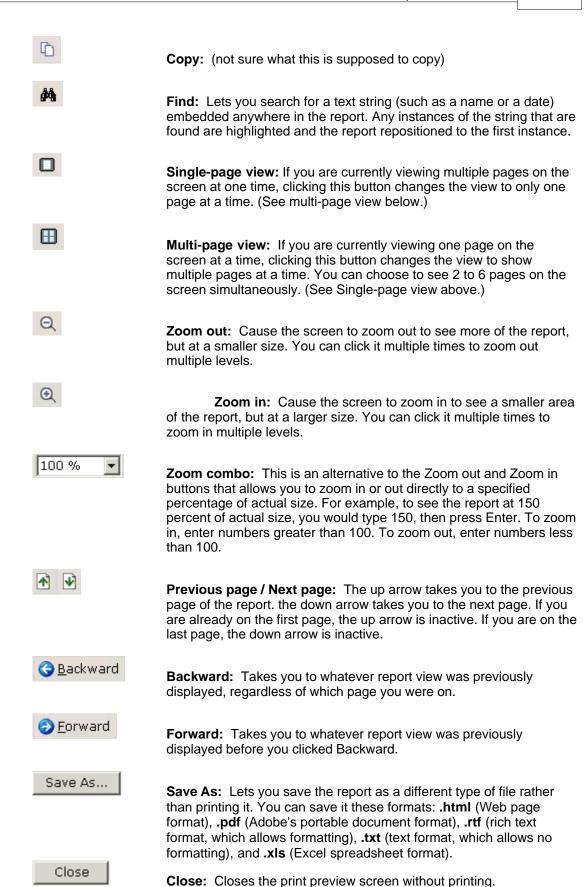
Note: When you export a report, the file created includes the date and time stamp so that unique files are created for each export (to avoid the possibility of an earlier report being over-written by error).

Print Preview Options

The print preview screen provides a number of controls for working with a report while you are viewing it in preview mode.



Print: Sends the report to your selected printer.

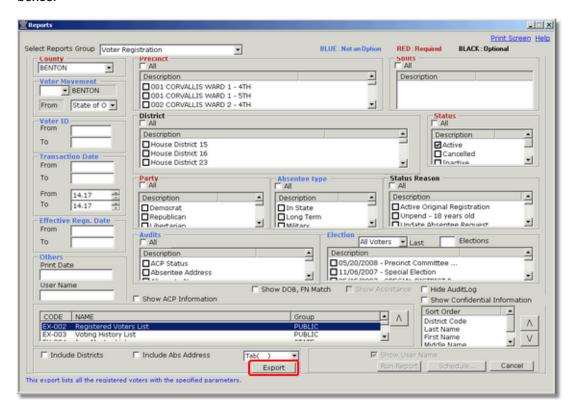


Note: The report headers of reports run for your jurisdiction can be set to show or not via the Remove Caption and Name for Reports County Parameter in the System Configuration module.

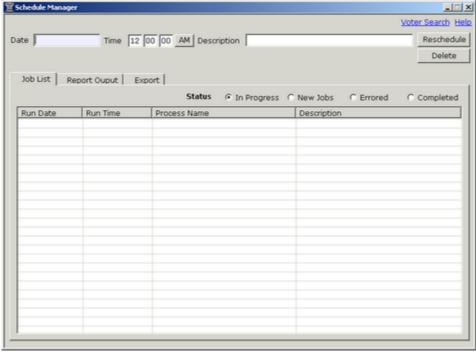
2.2 Exporting Reports

To export a report in OCVR, follow these steps:

- 1. Select the report category.
- 2. Scroll through the list of reports until you find the one you want, then highlight it. (Export-only reports have codes that start with the prefix EX.)
- Specify your data selection and sorting criteria using the various criteria lists and sort check boxes.

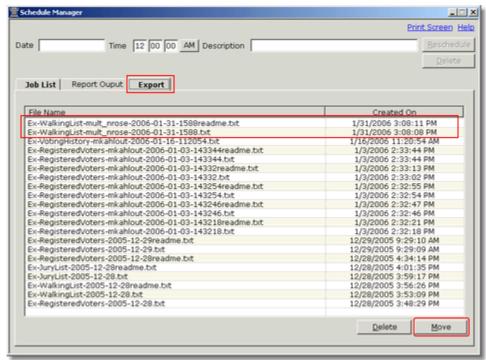


- Click Export. If you failed to specify any required criteria, a red error indicator displays next to the required item. Otherwise, the message: "1 records have been exported successfully" is shown.
- Click to close the Reports screen.
- 6. Select **Schedule Jobs** from the OCVR main menu. The Schedule Manager screen displays.



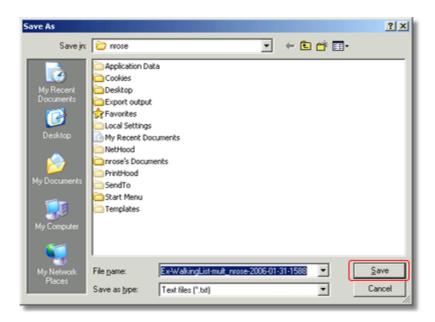
Schedule Manager screen

7. Select the **Export** tab. The report you exported is shown on the list with a system-supplied file name ending in .txt.



Schedule Manager Export tab

8. Highlight the report on the list, then click **Move**. The Save As screen displays.



The **File name** and **Save as type** fields are already filled in for you. However, these values can be changed before saving the file.

- 9. (Optional) Change the file name, if appropriate.
- 10. (Optional) If you want to save the file as a .txt file instead of an .xls file, select **Text files (*.txt)**
- 11. (Optional) Change the save destination by clicking on another folder until the folder you want is listed in the **Save in:** drop-down list at the top of the screen.
- 12. Click **Save**. The file is saved. You may now locate the file and open it, save it to removable media, e-mail it or transmit it via file transfer protocol (FTP) to someone else, if necessary.

2.3 Scheduling Reports

A scheduled report runs at a specified time with the most recent data available at the time it starts. When scheduling a report, you can schedule it to run one time or to run on some specified regular schedule. The report is saved to a specific location on your computer to be available to be viewed or printed at a convenient time. The computer does not need to be turned on for the report to run and be saved.

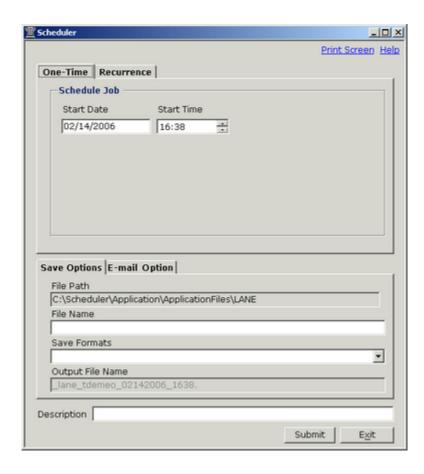
To open the Scheduler screen, select a report from the Reports screen, and then click **Schedule**.

Note: The Schedule button is not active when you have selected an export-only (Ex.) report.

On the Scheduler screen, you have two scheduling options:

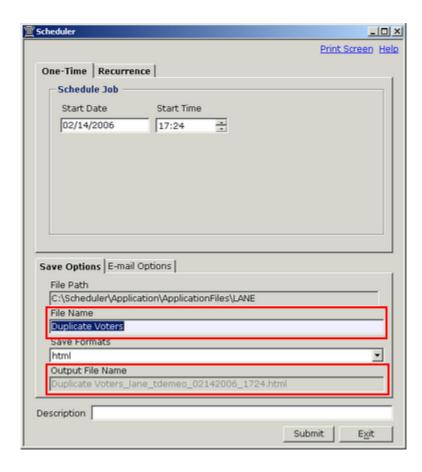
- Select the One-Time tab to schedule a one-time report at a future time.
- Select Recurrence to set up repeated printing of the report on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis.

Note: You might want to coordinate the scheduling of your report with others in your office, especially if it is a large report. It is best to schedule your larger reports at times when other large reports are not scheduled.

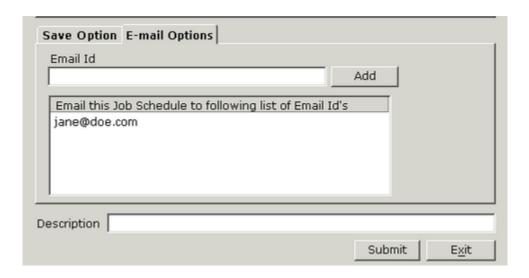


One-Time Scheduling

- 1. Enter the date and time you want to run the report. Enter the time using the 24-hour format (for example, 2:30 p.m. is entered as 14:30).
- 2. Select the **Save Options** tab, and enter the file name you want to use in the **File Name** field. This file name you enter is automatically added to the beginning of the information in the grayed out **Output File Name** field. In the example below, the file 'Duplicate Voters' text has automatically been added to the beginning of '_lane_tdemeo_02142006_1724' in the **Output File Name** field.



- 3. Select the file type for the report from the **Save Formats** drop-down list. The report can be saved as an html, pdf, rtf, txt, or xls file. The file extension automatically reflects your selection in the **File Name** field.
- 4. Select **E-mail Options** if you want to send the report file to an e-mail address.
- 5. Enter e-mail addresses in the **Email Id** field and click **Add** for each e-mail address that should receive the report each time it is run.



6. When you are done with your selections, click **Submit**.

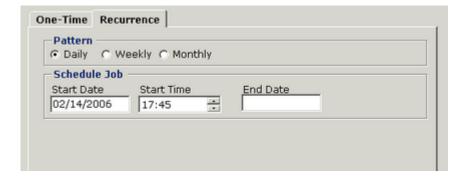
Recurrence Scheduling

This option can be used to set up reporting on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis.

Note: The Save Options and E-mail Options work the same way for this type of scheduling.

Daily

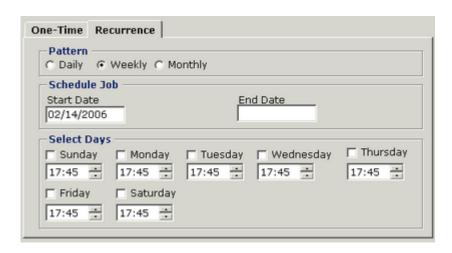
The report runs each day within the date range specified in the Start Date and End Date fields, and at the time specified in the Start Time field.



- 1. Enter the first day to begin running the report daily in **Start Date**.
- 2. Enter the time of day to run the report in **Start Time**.
- 3. Enter the last day to run the report in **End Date**. If you have no date on which you want the running of the report to stop, leave this field blank.

Weekly

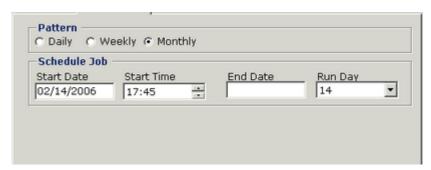
The report runs on the day(s) of the week and the times specified.



- 1. Enter the first day to begin running the report weekly in **Start Date**.
- 2. Enter the day you want the report to stop running in **End Date**. If you have no date on which you want the running of the report to stop, leave this field blank.
- 3. Select the day(s) of the week to run the report in **Select Days**.
- 4. Select the printing time for each of the selected days (each day can have its own independent printing time).

Monthly

The report runs on the day of the month you specify in the Run Day field, during the date range you specify in the Start Date and End Date fields, and at the time you select in the Start Time field.



- 1. Enter the date to begin running the report in **Start Date**.
- 2. Enter the time of day to run the report in **Start Time**.
- 3. Enter the last date to run the report in **End Date**. If you have no date on which you want the running of the report to stop, leave this field blank.
- 4. Enter the day of the month to run the report in **Run Day**.

2.4 Confidential Phone Numbers in Reports

There are very specific rules which govern when the phone numbers of ACP and Confidential voters are shown in reports. These pertain mainly to the Registered Voters Report (VR-011) and Registered Voters List Export (EX-002).

- 1. When the "Show Confidential Information" checkbox in Reports & Labels is not checked by the user, regardless of the user's privileges:
- For Confidential voters who Do have the Unlisted checkbox marked in their Voter Registration record, XXX-XXXX is shown in place of their phone number.
- For Confidential voters who do Not have the Unlisted checkbox marked in their Voter Registration record, the phone number is shown.
 - For ACP voters, ACP is always shown in place of the phone number.
 - For all other voters, the phone number is shown, regardless if it is marked as unlisted or not.
- 2. When the "Show Confidential Information" checkbox in Reports & Labels is marked by the user (only users with the View Confidential Data privilege are able to do this):
- For Confidential voters who Do have the Unlisted checkbox marked in their Voter Registration record the unlisted phone number is now shown (as is the address and DOB).
- For Confidential voters who do Not have the Unlisted checkbox marked in their Voter Registration record, the phone number is shown.
- For ACP voters, ACP is always shown in place of the phone number whether or not they have the Unlisted checkbox marked.
 - For all other voters, the phone number is shown, regardless if it is marked as unlisted or not.
- 3. When the "Show ACP Information" checkbox in Reports & Labels is marked by the user (only users with the View ACP Voters privilege are able to do this):
- For Confidential voters who do have the Unlisted checkbox marked in their Voter Registration record, XXX-XXXX is shown in place of their phone number.
- For Confidential voters whose phone number is not marked as unlisted in their Voter Registration record, the phone number is shown.
- For ACP voters, the phone number is shown whether or not they have the Unlisted checkbox marked.

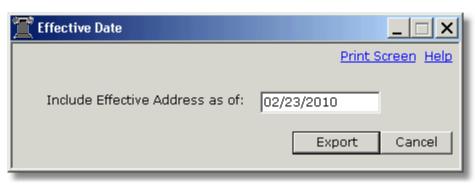

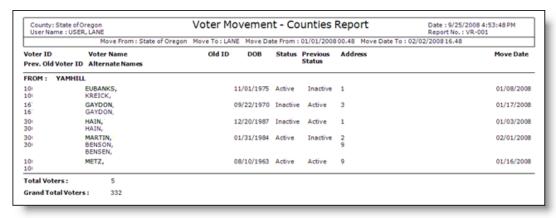

3.0 Schedule Jobs

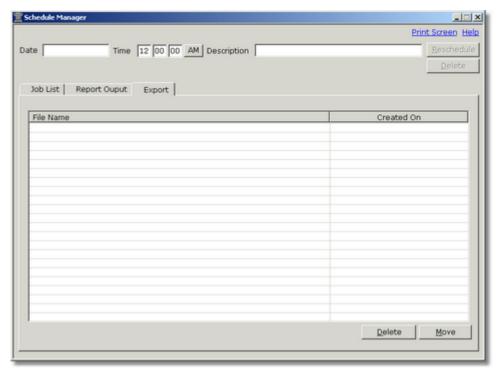
Jobs that are run on a regular basis can be placed in queues and scheduled to run on specified days (of the month or the week) and at specified times as needed from several of the OCVR modules. These are primarily report jobs. You can use the Schedule Jobs module to manage those scheduled jobs—organizing, rescheduling, or deleting them.

Access the Schedule Jobs Module

To access the Schedule Jobs module, select **Schedule Jobs** under the **Reports** section heading on the OCVR main menu.



The Schedule Manager screen opens.

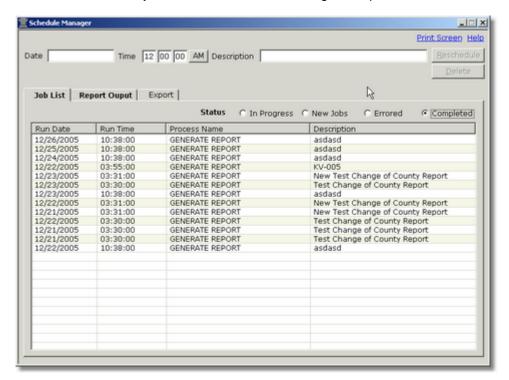

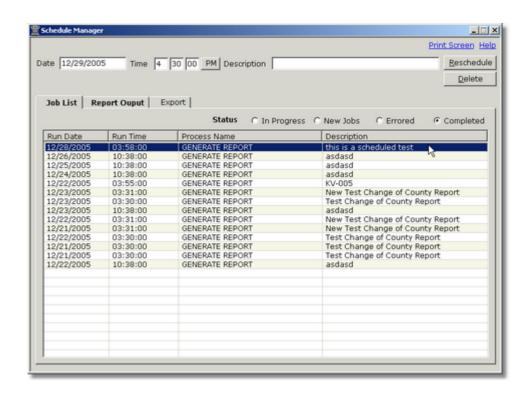
The Schedule manager screen is made up of two sections: the scheduling options at the top of the screen, and three tabs as follows: Job List, Report and Export.

3.1 Scheduling Section

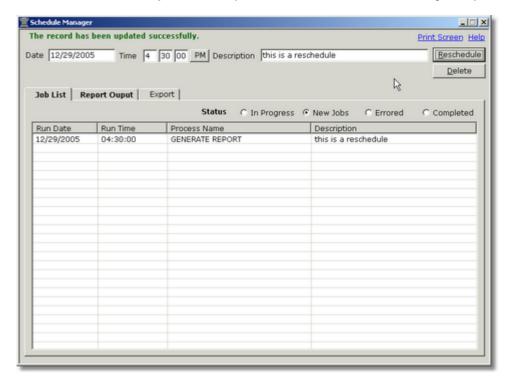
The scheduling section of the Schedule Manager screen contains Date, Time, and Description fields. This section is where you can reschedule the running of a report.



In order to activate the scheduling section to reschedule a job, you must choose an item on the **Job List** tab.



When you choose a job on the list, the **Reschedule** and **Delete** buttons are activated. Enter the new **Date**, **Time**, and **Description** for the job and click **Reschedule** to change the job schedule.



You can also select a job on the **Job List** tab and click **Delete** to remove the job from the schedule.

3.2 Job List Tab

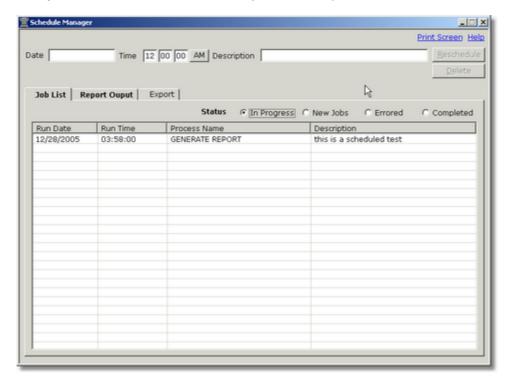
The Job List tab displays a list of scheduled jobs with a choice status, including the following:

In Progress: This list shows jobs currently running.

New Jobs: This list shows newly scheduled jobs that have not yet been processed.

Errored: This list shows scheduled jobs that did not complete due to some error condition.

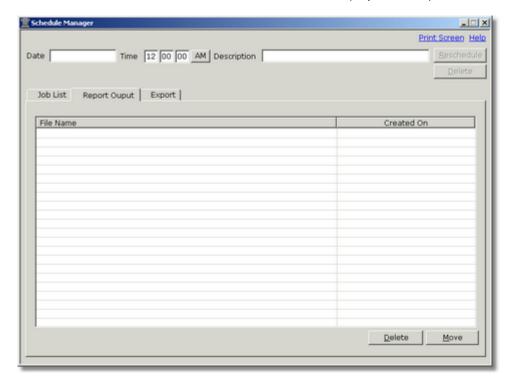
Completed: This list shows scheduled jobs that completed as defined.



You can select a job from any of the lists on this tab and either Reschedule or Delete the job.

3.3 Report Output Tab

The Report Output tab displays a list of scheduled jobs that have been processed. This list shows the file name and the date and time the file was created (or processed).

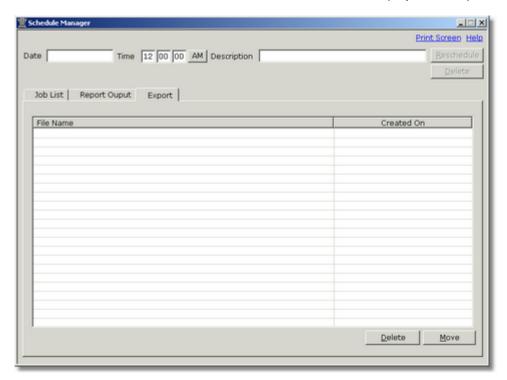


You can select any file on this list and either delete it or save the file to another location. To delete a file, select it and click **Delete**. To move the file to another location, select the file and click **Move**. When the standard Windows Save prompt displays, select the path and file name you want to use and click **Save**.



3.4 Export Tab

The Export tab displays a list of scheduled jobs that have been processed and exported. This list shows the file name and the date and time the file was created (or processed).



You can select any file on this list and either delete it or save the file to another location. To delete a file, select it and click **Delete**. To move the file to another location, select the file and click **Move**. When the standard Windows Save prompt displays, select the path and file name you want to use and click **Save**.



4.0 Batch Management

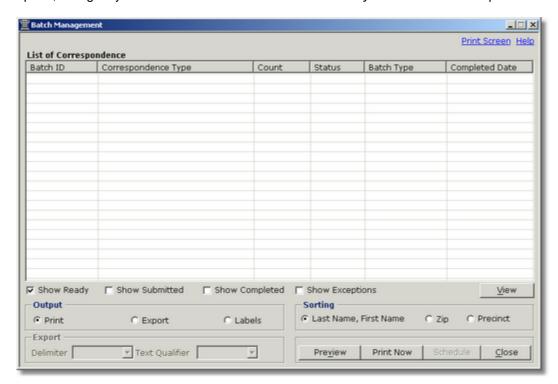
The Batch Management module allows you to view, print, and/or export batches of voter correspondence that have been generated in other modules. The two main types of voter correspondence—Voter Notification Cards (VNCs) and Voter Confirmation Cards (VCCs)—are generated in the Voter Registration module, although other functions and modules, such as Districts and Precincts, can generate correspondence as well.

Access the Batch Management Module

To access the Batch Management module, select **Batch Management** under the Reports section heading on the OCVR main menu.



The system selects the **Show Ready** check box by default when the Batch Management screen first opens, listing only the batches that have the status of *Ready* in the List of Correspondence section.



You can view the other batches by selecting the Show Submitted, Show Completed, or Show

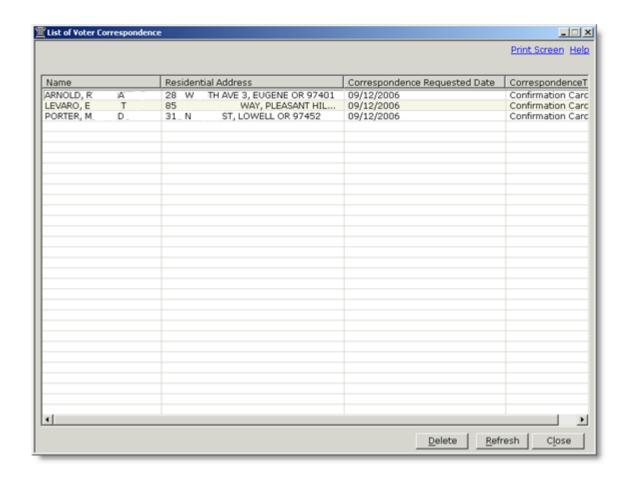
Exceptions check boxes near the bottom of the screen. These batches automatically display when you select a box:



The Status options are defined as follows:

- **Show Ready:** These batches are ready to be exported or printed. Select this option to show batches that have been printed or exported. The type of action is shown in the Batch Type column in the List of Correspondence section. An example of a Batch Type is *Extract*. These batches are ready to be exported or printed.
- **Show Submitted:** This option shows newly generated batches. These batches are ready to be exported or printed.
- **Show Completed:** Select this option to show batches that have been successfully printed or exported, and show a Completed Date in the List of Correspondence section.
- Show Exceptions: Select this option to show batches containing errors that must be addressed.

To view the details of a specific batch, select it and click **View**. The List of Voter Correspondence screen displays, showing the list of voters in this batch:

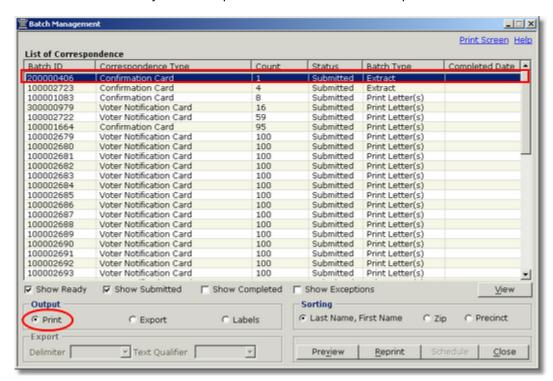


Using the buttons at the bottom of the screen, you can delete a voter record from the batch, refresh the listing of the batch, or close this screen.

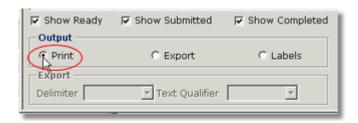
4.1 Print a Batch

Print batches of correspondence as follows:

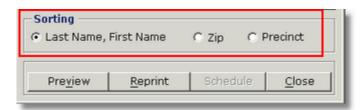
1. Select the batch you want to print listed in the List of Correspondence section:



2. Select **Print** in the Output section (normally the default).



3. Select the Sorting option you want to use. Each option sorts alphabetically, or numerically from smallest to largest. The default setting is *Last Name*, *First Name*.



4. Click **Preview**. A message displays, prompting you that the system will add the

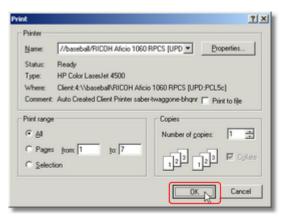
selected item(s) to the existing batch and whether or not you want to continue:



5. Click **Yes** to display the Reports print preview screen:



6. To print this batch, click **Print** on the Reports screen. The standard Windows Print selection screen displays, where you can select the printer to use, the number of copies to print, and the exact page or set of pages you want to print:

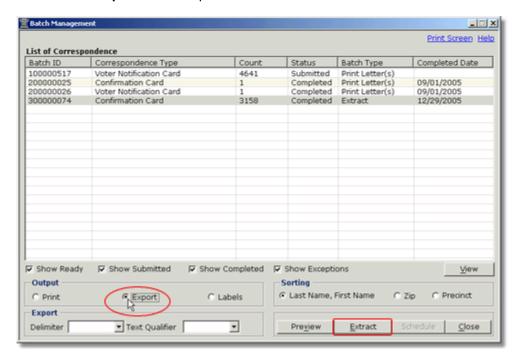


7. After making your selections, click **OK** to complete the print job. The message, "Batch Job Printed", displays at the top of the Batch Management screen.

4.2 Export a Batch

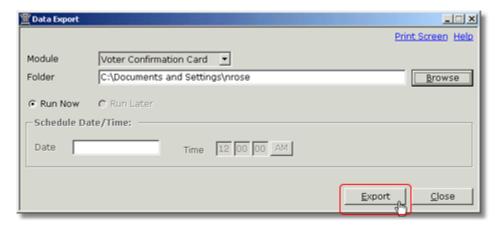
To export a batch of correspondence to a data file on your server or workstation, proceed as follows:

- 1. Select the batch you want to export from the List of Correspondence section.
- 2. Select **Export** in the Output section.



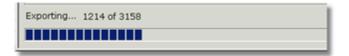

4. Click **Browse** to define the path to use for the file to be exported, and then click **Export**.

5.0 Glossary of OCVR Terms

Address Range: This appears in the Address Library and refers to a street

segment that includes a range of house numbers (From and To), a city, a ZIP code, a precinct, and a split. A voter's residence address must be in an existing address range to be

considered valid.

APO-FPO: These are acronyms used in military addresses. They stand for

Army Post Office and Fleet Post Office. When entered in a voter record, this designation switches the address to a

non-standard address automatically

Ballot Packet: A ballot packet refers to the complete package that is sent to

voters, which includes the mailing envelope, the secrecy envelope, the mailing label, and the actual ballot. The OCVR application only deals with processing the ballot packets—it

does not process the actual ballots.

Ballot Style: This refers to a specific combination of content and physical

characteristics on a voter's ballot. The Ballot Style is

determined by the residential address, political party affiliation (for a primary election), preferred secondary language (other than English), and special assistance needs (such as a Braille

ballot) of a voter.

Two voters could live next door to each other in the same precinct and split but could still receive different ballot styles.

CASS: This is the Coding Accuracy Support System, which is an

address standardization and verification process. The U.S. Postal Service contracts with several vendors around the country who use address standardization software to verify whether addresses conform to U.S.P.S. formatting standards. Counties can submit voter registration addresses to one of these vendors and receive an importable file that indicates

which addresses are non-standard.

Commit (a batch): This is the process of moving a batch of document images

(such as voter registration cards) that have been scanned and currently reside on the user's local workstation to the remote

Citrix server for processing.

CSV: This stands for **c**omma-**s**eparated **v**alues, and refers to a text

file that contains records that have been exported from a database. Each record contains multiple data fields separated by a comma to delineate where one field ends and the next field begins. Data in this format can be imported into an Excel

spreadsheet or other data management tool.

CVR: This stands for Centralized Voter Registration. CVR is the

generic term for the key component of Saber's Electustm software.

Delimiter: This is a character—such as a comma or a semicolon—that is

used to mark, or delimit, the end of one data field and the beginning of the next data field in a text file containing

exported database records.

District: Also known as a "voting district" or "taxing district." This is a

self-governing jurisdiction with defined geographic boundaries that has the authority to provide various services (such as fire and police protection) or political representation. A district is normally governed by a group of elected officials and typically holds elections to vote candidates into office or decide on various issues affecting people in that district. Districts can overlap each other as well as precincts and splits. There are local districts, countywide districts, statewide districts and

federal districts.

DL: Drivers License

DMV: Department of Motor Vehicles

DOT: Department of Transportation

DPH: Department of Public Health

Exception: This refers to an exception ballot. This is a ballot packet that

has a problem, such as being the second ballot submitted by

the same voter for the same election.

Flex labels: Customizable labels that are maintained in the Electustm

System Configuration module for use in a wide range of mailing purposes, such as mailing absentee ballots to voters. This capability allows the user to design labels by dragging data fields from a list onto a rectangular area that represents the finished label, and then positioning these fields where desired. The list of fields includes such data as voter ID, voter

name, residence address and ballot ID.

FPCA: Federal Post Card Application

FWAB: Federal Write-in Absentee Ballots

HAVA: Help America Vote Act of 2002. The main purpose of this

federal legislation was to provide incentives for states to improve their voting systems and procedures, including both

software and hardware.

HCF: Health Care Facility

ID: Identification

NCOA: National Change of Address

Non-Standard Address: A residential address that cannot be broken up into standard

components, such as house number, street name, street type and ZIP code, and therefore is not verified against the Address Library of valid address ranges when adding or updating a

voter's registration record. (See Standard Address.)

NVRA: National Voter Registration Application

OCVR: Oregon Centralized Voter Registration system.

Precinct: This is a political subdivision within a county or a city. In polling

place states, it exists to provide a common physical location where all residents within it go to vote. Precincts within the same county are supposed to have roughly equal numbers of voters, especially immediately after the 10-year census. Precincts do not overlap each other and do not normally represent an independently governed voting district with tax and spend authority. Precincts are further subdivided into smaller areas referred to as splits or sub-precincts or precinct

parts, depending on what part of the county you are in.

Preprocess: In the Petitions module of Electustm, this is refers to marking

specific signature lines on specific pages of a petition that are "bad," meaning they cannot be used for creating a random

sample for signature verification.

Role: A specific combination of permissions assigned to a system

user in Electustm. Roles are maintained and assigned in the

User Administration module.

SOS: Secretary of State

Soundex: A feature in the Voter Search module that lets the user search

for voters by the pronunciation ("sound") of a name or other

value rather than by spelling.

Split: As most commonly used, "split" refers to a geographic area

(defined by a combination of adjacent address ranges) that represents a unique combination of overlapping voting districts. Every person in the same split will see issues and candidates on their ballots for the same group of voting districts in any given election, although different voters in the same split could receive different ballot styles. Splits do not overlap each other and do not overlap precinct boundaries.

SSA: Social Security Administration

SSN: Social Security Number

Standard Address: A residential address that can be broken up into standard

components, such as house number, street name, street type and ZIP code, and therefore can be verified against the Address Library when adding or updating a voter's registration

record. (See Non-Standard Address.)

Submarine Ballot: Special ballot for the voter who is unable to vote (because they

live in a remote area or are located on a submarine) and a return ballot by normal mail delivery within the period provided

for regular absentee ballots.

Submittal: A group or batch of signed petitions that are submitted for

verification.

VR: Voter Registration

Workspace: 1) The election workspace. This is a table in Electus that

stores the list of eligible voters for the current election. It is generated in the Election Management module during the Ballot Styles step. Generating the election workspace assigned a ballot ID to each eligible voter that is unique to that voter and

that election.

2) The practice area available on the Splits tab of the Districts and Precincts module and the Address Library. The workspace

allows the users to enter data without affecting the live production environment. When the data looks acceptable, it can then be committed to the current live area of the system.
