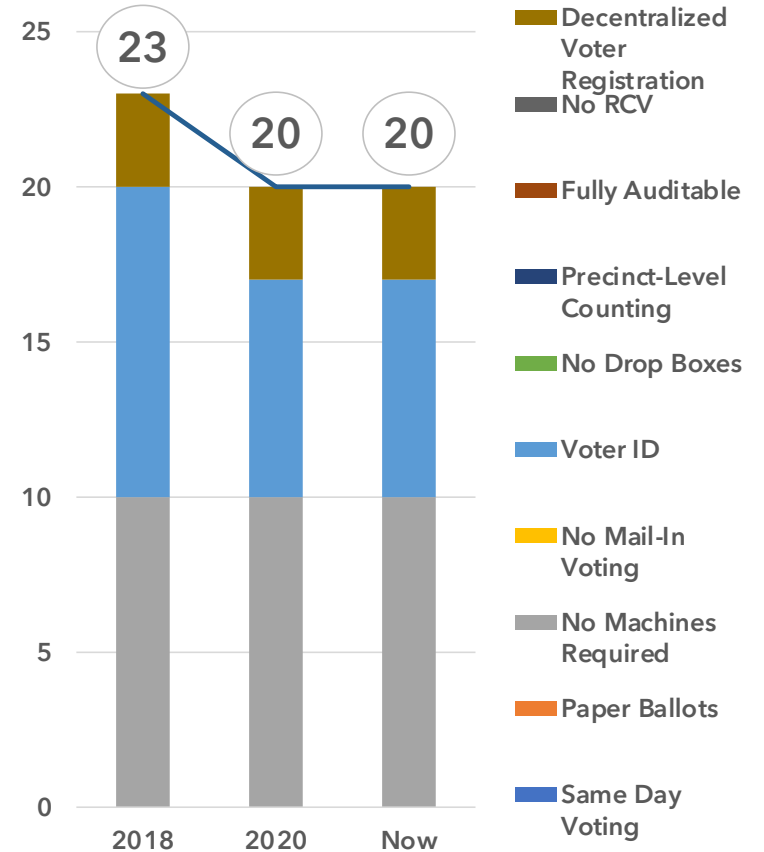

### Reason for Hope



- **Grassroots Patriots were able to get an America First Candidate elected as Kansas GOP Party Chairman.**
- **In 2022, Kansas elected Mike Brown GOP State Party Chairman. Mike is an election integrity advocate who ran for Secretary of State on a platform to remove electronic voting systems from our elections but ultimately “lost” to Scott Schwab who just happens to be the President of the National Association of Secretaries of State (NASS).**



## Reason for Hope: Legislative Success



### Kansas

- **Background:** Earlier this year, HB2086 was sold as Scott Schwab's "cleanup bill" but was in fact a "cover-up bill" to change our election statutes to codify the use of digital images in post-election recounts/audits instead of the Voter-Verified Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) ballot.
- The bill had 117 statutory changes overall. It passed the house unamended and unanimously.
- But when the bill got to the Senate, Kansas Patriots stepped up during the committee hearings to call out the bill and its failings.
- The bill was amended in the Senate and the provision to use digital images in post-election recounts/audits (among others) was stricken from the bill.
