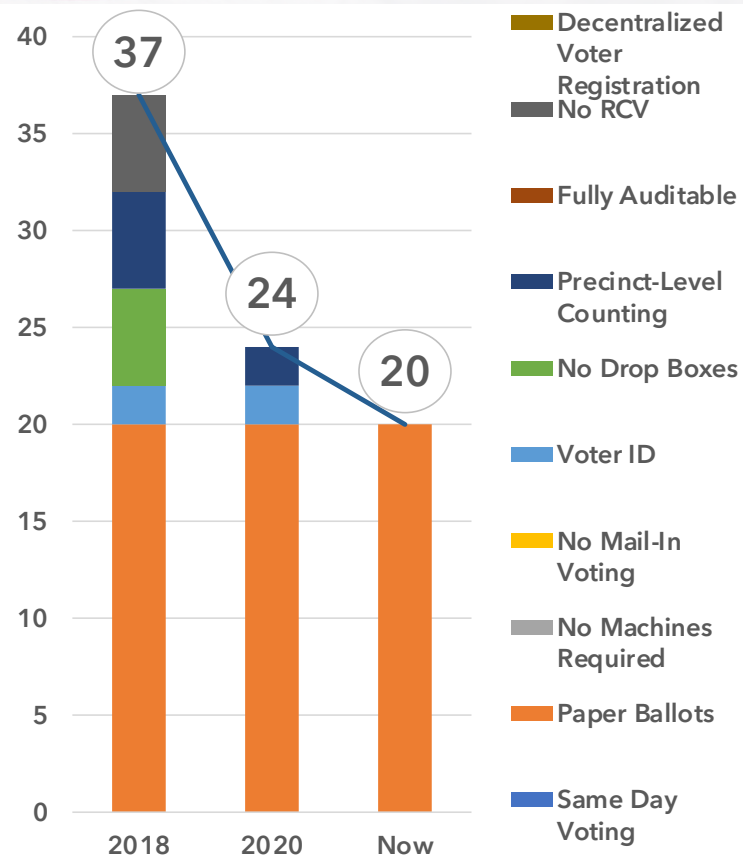

- After adamant fights on election integrity bills, the SoS office was allotted one million dollars to study H.A.V.A. level 4 compliance.
- The takeover of multiple legislative districts as well as the state G.O.P. chair and board.
- Testimony with supporting evidence was presented during the legislative session in an attempt to better support the bills being presented.

Reason for Hope: Lawsuit Success

Splonskowski v. White, No. 1:23-cv-00123-DMT-CRH

Challenges the North Dakota Century Code regarding absentee and mail in ballots and the time frame for which they can be accepted. The lawsuit contends that as long as the ballots are post marked the day before the election they can be accepted and counted up to 13 days after the election.
