The EAC has been made aware by one voting system manufacturer that they have been experiencing an increase in system penetration hacking attempts, including social engineering attack vectors through email and phone contact. Attempts have been made to obtain voting equipment, security information and in general to probe for vulnerabilities. We wanted you all to be aware of this information and to let you know we have made all of our voting system manufacturers and Voting System Test Laboratories aware.
