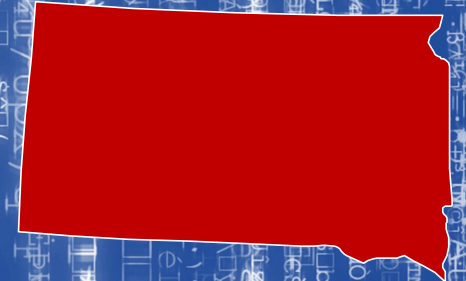

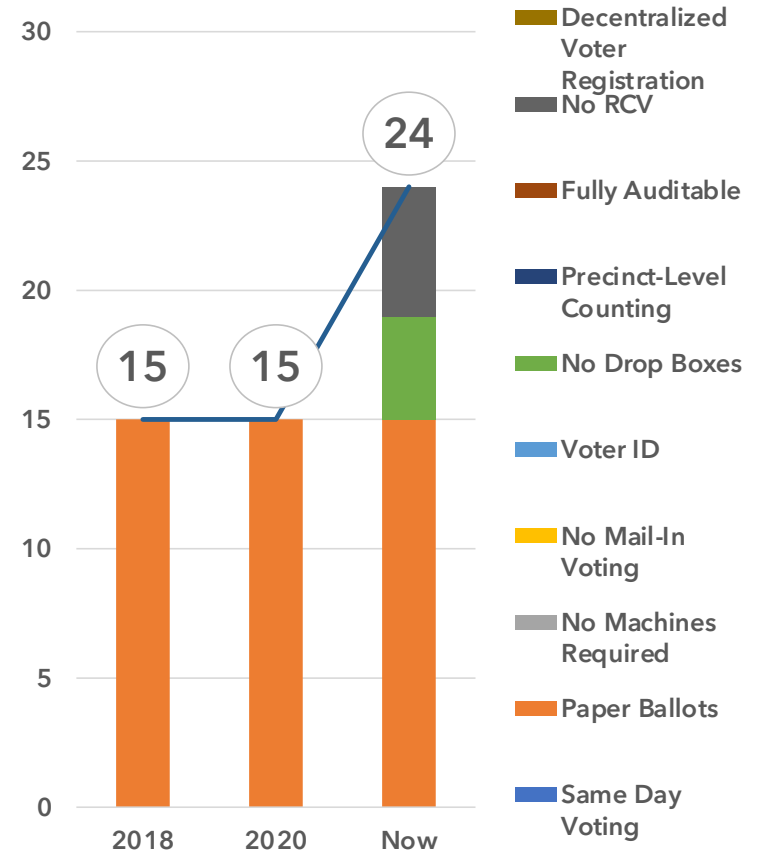

Reason for Hope



South Dakota

- Citizens are speaking up and getting involved
- Some County GOP Executive Boards now promoting election security
- Minnehaha County elected a patriot to County Auditor position
- SD Freedom Caucus has made elections one of their top five issues
- Hand Counting elections is majority of state election code - no law change needed
- We are just getting started!

Reason for Hope: Legislative Success



South Dakota

- Enacted post-election audit
- Banned ranked choice voting
- Banned drop boxes
- Exposed the RINOS
- Engaged the public to participate in the legislative process

2022

- 5 election related bills
- 1 passed banning NGO funding of elections

2023

- 100 election related bills drafted
- 35 introduced
- 16 passed

Reason for Hope: Lawsuit Success



South Dakota

- **Cast Vote Record lawsuit refiled with Hearing Examiner - in progress currently awaiting upcoming hearing**
- **State and County Officials and ES&S reps changed their answers (LIES) due to the evidence we presented**
- **We will win IF weighed on FACTS and EVIDENCE**

Reason for Hope: Hand Count Success



South Dakota

- Tripp County Commission voted to hand count 2022 general election
- Tripp County hand count identifies ES&S machines out of compliance with EAC standards
- Counties petitioned by citizens to hand count and defund the machines
- Precinct hand counts possible in 2024
- Citizens demanding hand counting in their counties
