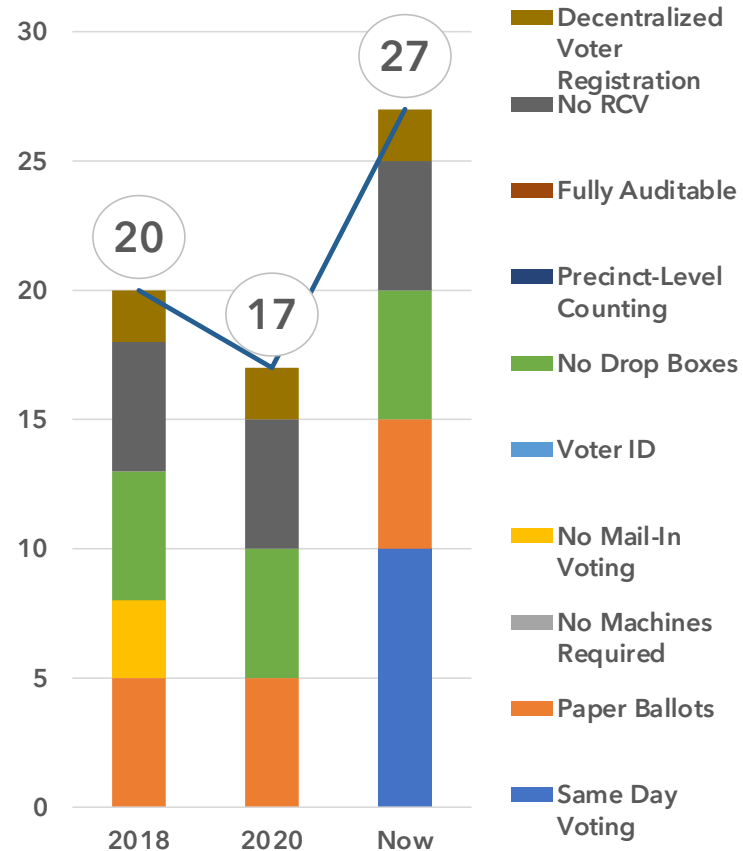

Reason for Hope



New Hampshire

- New Hampshire 9 cases dropped!!
- Governor Sununu is not running in 2024!
- 2022 SoS Confidence Committee recommendations will drive support for necessary legislation.
- New Hampshire Law passed requiring voter residency & identification for Same Day voters
- SoS forced to send email to all towns confirming the requirement to clean voter rolls of USPS permanent movers.
- State level senate race- recount audit referred to Attorney General
- Increasing awareness and citizen participation: Overturned town selectman Race Sandown



Reason for Hope: Lawsuit Success

In process NH SUPREME Court Case:

- **Constitutionality of Voting Machines**
- **Absentee Ballot affidavit process**
- **Expansion of non constitutional reasons for Absentee Ballots**
- **Citizenship - who is & who is not an NH citizen with voting rights**



Reason for Hope: Hand Count Success



New Hampshire

2022 Hand count slot added to election machines

- Instructions were sent by the Secretary of State providing this option to NH Towns for the 2022 election year
- ~60% compliance by towns

Some towns voted on removing the machines: Positive Momentum

- First set of elections March 2022: citizens voted 90% to keep machines
- Second set of elections November 2022: citizens voted 40% to keep machines
- Unfortunately, these results were calculated by the machines!

Election machines are now required to spit out over- vote ballots to be hand counted and adjudicated.
