ERIC in Collin County

We have approximately 16,000 registrations on our Collin County Voter Roster who show as moved out of Collin County.

We have approximately 21,000 registrations on our Collin County Voter Roster who show as moved out of State.

Of those out of county but still in State, about 1,500 voted in the last election.

We are surveying those houses and we have found about 50% of those who are out of county no longer live at the registered residence.

We are also finding many more who did not vote, but moved and should no longer be on the voter rolls.

We have also found 76 people who are deceased on our voter rolls. One has been deceased for 10 years.

This is only one county. If you multiply these numbers times 254 counties, you can see that elections can be won or lost based on these invalid registrations.
