

TEXAS VOTING ROSTER MOVING TARGET ANALYSIS

NOVEMBER 2022 General Election

Comparing 30 NOV 2022 to 24 FEB 2023

When someone votes it is an event that happens in space and time. It is fixed. The person either voted or did not vote. The State of Texas Secretary of State office voting roster system seems to think otherwise. The voting roster is a moving target – often many months after an election.

Consider – the early voting roster is reported on the state website as official. Here is what it looks like on 5 MAR 2023 specifically for the early voting date of October 27, 2022:

If this value is official, then why is it changing over the course of time?

How can an official state number change months after the election?

Analyzing State-wide MAIL IN VOTERS from Oct 2 to November 4 (early voting) we see the following anomalies:

Date	Total Votes
30 NOV 2022	324,183
24 FEB 2023	317,412

When we dig in a little deeper and look at the individual voters who allegedly voted we find the following:

Item	Count
Voters Added after NOV 30	3,391
Voters Deleted after NOV 30	4,376
Voters Deleted with no name registered but with a VUID and precinct	3,082
Voters whose VUID (unique voter ID) Changes	2,693
